- **Required:**

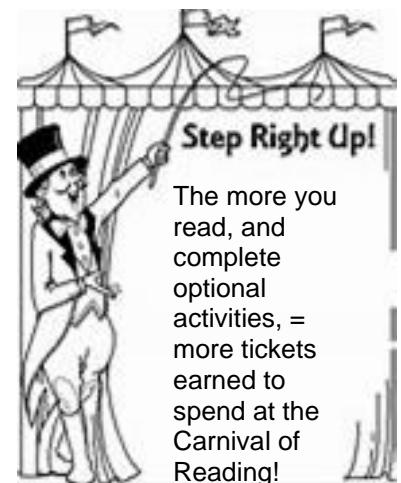
- **Daily Reading Log:** 1 ticket for every 5 days of reading

- **Genre List:** 1 ticket for every 5 different genres read

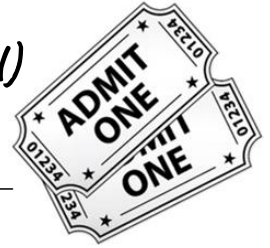
Tickets earned will gain you:

Daily minimum reading: K-3rd: 20min / 4th-5th: 30min

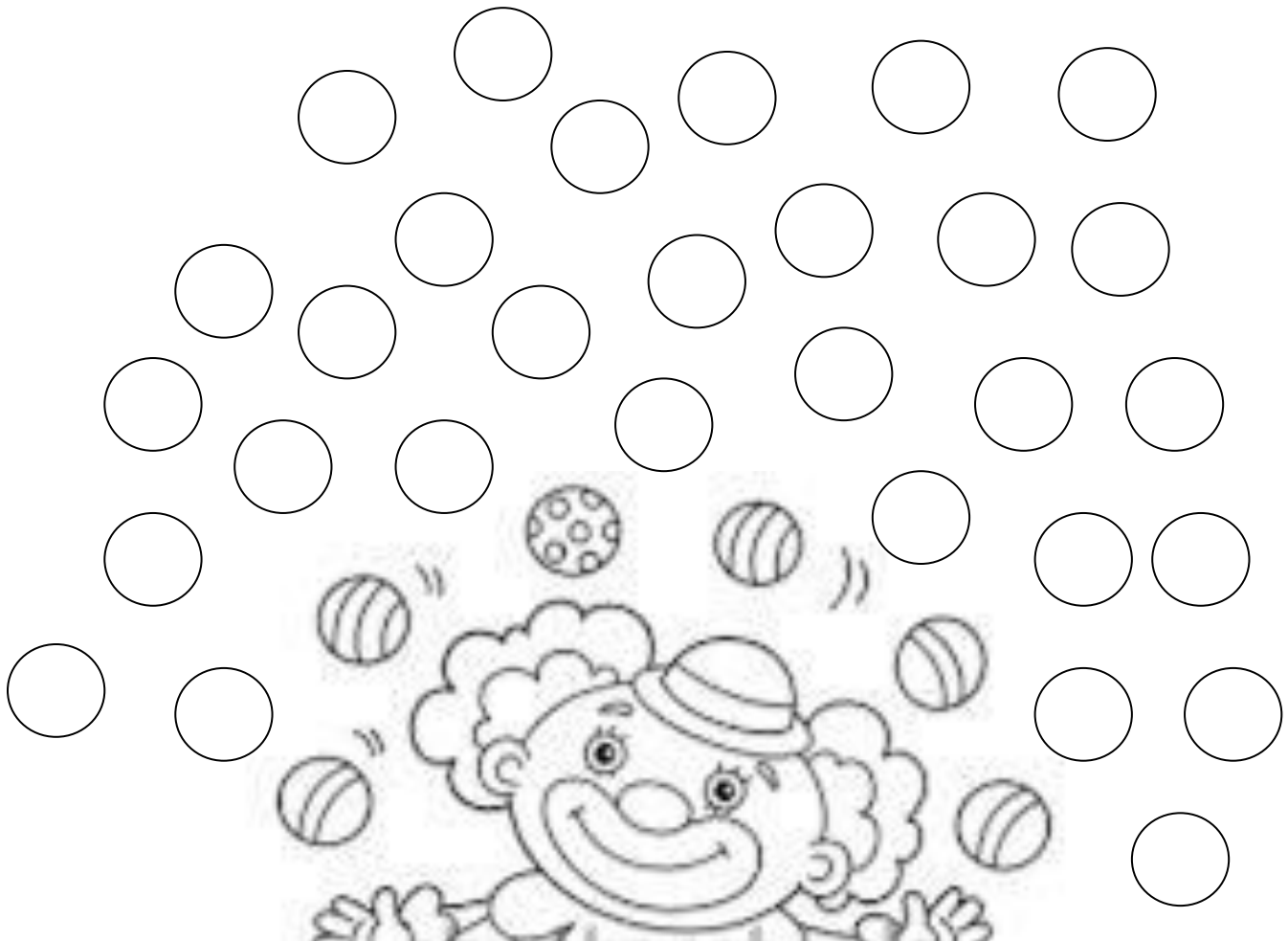
Note: K & 1st: student may read or be read to (2nd-5th: student must read)

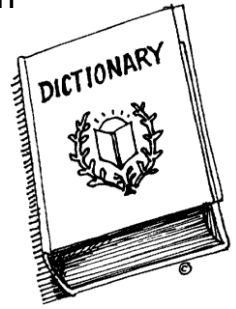

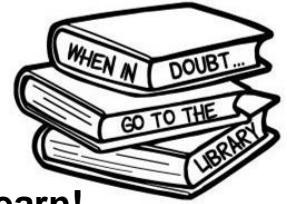

 - Describe the setting
 - What is the problem at the root of the story's action? What is the conflict?
 - What is the highest point of action?
 - How does the story come to its conclusion?
 - What is the main idea of the story?
