**Minimum reading** (by grade entering): **K-3rd: 20min/day / 4th-5th: 30min/day**

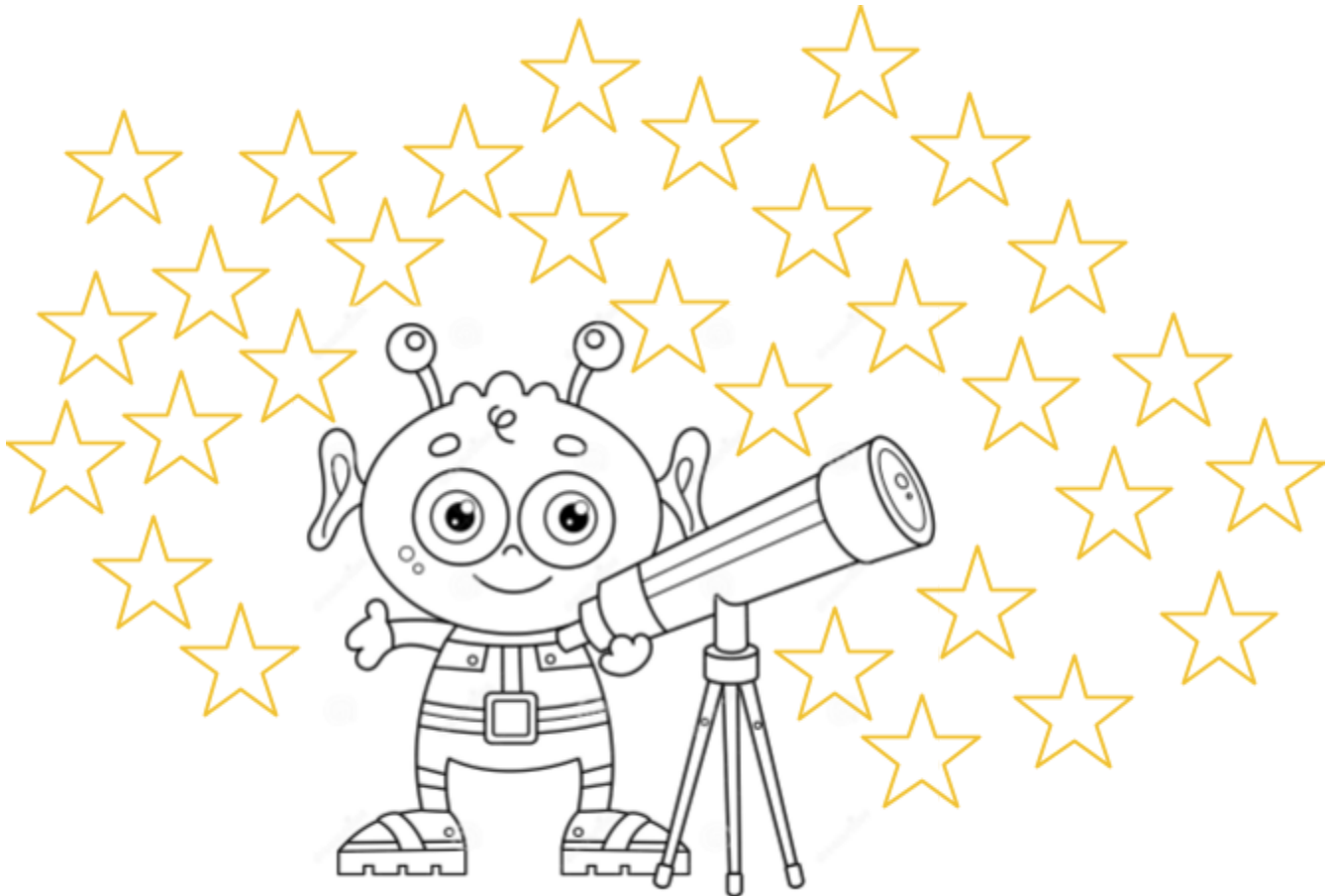
**Note:** K & 1st student may read or be read to (2nd-5th: student must read)

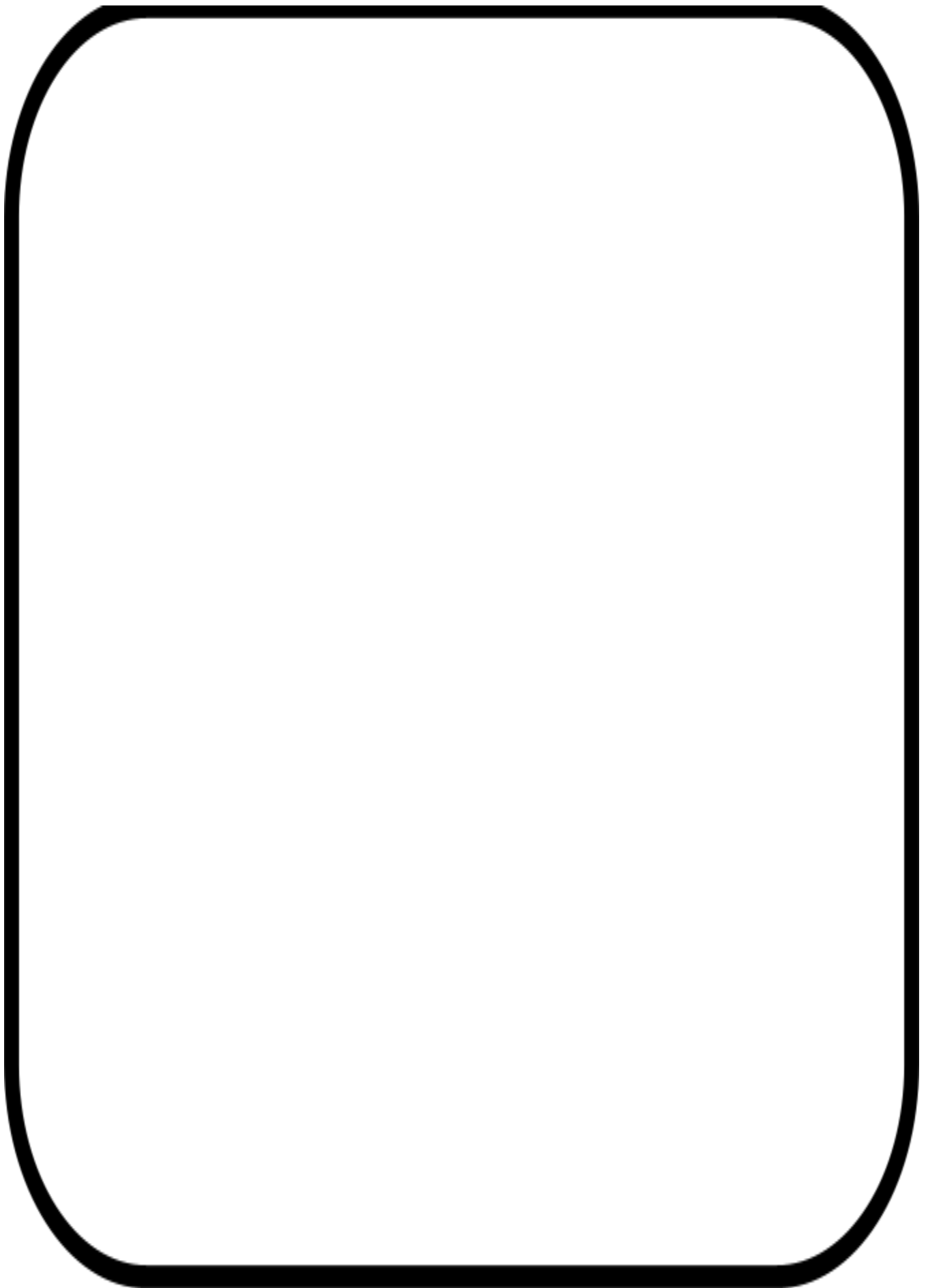

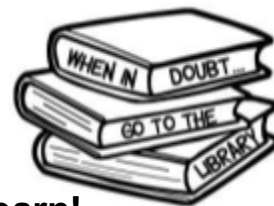
- **K-3rd:** choose to write a short summary **and/or** draw a picture of your favorite scene.
