- 1) Keep track of each book you read this summer.
- 2) Have a **parent sign off** on the bottom of the log verifying that you read all of the books listed.
- 3) Return the paper log to the school library, on the first day of school. (The more you read = the more scratch-n-win tickets you earn! See details below.)
- Log all books you read (from 6/8 8/29).
 - Books should be 200+ pages (nonfiction chapter books should aim for nothing less than 170 pages)
- Scratch-off tickets will be earned based on the types of books you read:
 - One ticket for every 1 great classics
 - One ticket for every 1 nonfiction (middle school level, or higher)
 - One ticket for every 2 historical fiction books
 - One ticket for every 3 general fiction books
- Earning more tickets will increase your odds for the top prizes: Not all tickets are instant winners, so the more tickets you get will increase your chance to get the top prizes.
 - Easy to win: Snack/treat, Root Beer Float/ice cream/popsicles, extra NCA Spirit Wear Day,
 - Harder to win: 3 extra credit points on one test (for bible, science, history or literature class), gift card, free lunch or drink (Starbucks, Chick-fil-a, Wendy's, etc)

 - Read & log a max of 16 historical fiction books = max 8 tickets
 - Earn even more tickets if you read great **classic** or **nonfiction** chapter books (<u>not</u> juvenile trivia/facts style nonfiction books). 1 ticket for each great classic or nonfiction book!
