our collaborative digital mosaic & add one virtual sticker/per day. You can enter your name & leave a short message to tell us all about a favorite book that you just finished reading.




Note for parents:

- Do you have multiple children all reading the same day and all want to log their virtual sticker?
- No problem! ... But, please note that the QR code is set to allow only one sticker per day, per device. If you have multiple children, then each one can still add their daily virtual sticker by using different devices. (Solution: Scan the QR code for child #1 on mom's phone, scan again for child #2 on dad's phone, and for child #3 scan on the tablet device or enter the web address directly from your computer.)



- No app or login needed. Just visit the website each day the student reads:
- They select a color & then find a blank corresponding square.
- In the lower right corner, use the blue square with a messaging option with two small grey fields to enter their "Name" and "Message".

Hopefully they will have fun sharing brief messages with each other about the great books they are reading this summer.

Help your child be able to narrate the story back to you by asking the right questions!

When reading with your child, check for understanding by asking questions.

Don't just ask questions at the end, it's important to check for understanding before, during, and after reading. Here are some questions to ask!

<u>Before</u>

- What do you think will happen in this story?
- What might be the problem?
- Where may be the setting of the story?
- What do you know about this topic?
- What does this story make you think of?
- What are you wondering?
- What does the title tell you?

During

- What do you think will happen next?
- What can you tell me about the story so far?
- How do you feel about the story so far?
- What questions do you have?
- Why do you think the character did that?
- What would you have done?

After

- What was the title?
- What was the problem/solution in the story?
- Why do you think the author wrote this book?
- What was your favorite/least favorite part?
- What would you change about the story?
- What will happen next?
